Nursing Facility Services *

99307 - 99310	Subsequent nursing facility care (per day) which requires at least 2 of 3 components: 1) Problem-focused interval history 2) Problem-focused examination 3) Medical decision making that is straightforward or of low complexity, moderate complexity to high complexity.
99315 - 99316	Nursing Facility Discharge Services.
99318	Nursing Facility Annual Assessment, which requires 3 components: 1) Detailed interval history 2) Comprehensive examination 3) Medical decision making that is low to moderate complexity.
